ZONE-TURITIES: Open to APHA-registered horses only; **100%** of entry fees added to purse; No additional entry fee for concurrent awards/bonuses where offered; Additional entries are accepted until the last horse is on course or the gate is closed; Classes will follow APHA rules unless otherwise noted; APHA Ownership rules apply. Amateur or Youth cards must be included with Non-Pro entries; Horses will be lined up for individual judge's placings before overall placings;

Donna Ruth Memorial Walk Trot Trail. Exhibitors must have a valid APHA Walk-Trot card to be eligible.

Donna Ruth Memorial Open & Non-Pro Trail: Exhibitors may show up to four horses. \$250 added to Open purse, \$125 added to Non-Pro purse. Non-Pros are automatically eligible for Open and Non-Pro results and must follow APHA ownership rules. Non-Pro results will be recognized separately.

Judy Ashbacher Memorial Novice Showmanship: Exhibitors must have a current Novice card to be eligible. May show up to two horses. .

Judy Ashbacher Memorial All Ages Showmanship: Exhibitors may show up to two horses. \$250 added to Open purse, \$125 added to Non-Pro purse. Non-Pros are automatically eligible for Open and Non-Pro results and must follow APHA ownership rules. Non-Pro results will be recognized separately.

Tri-Challenge All Ages Versatility

Open to all exhibitors! A combination between Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation (on the rail), and Western Command Class. The arena will be cut off to allow a holding area inside the main show arena.

1. A Showmanship pattern will be provided to exhibitors as they enter the arena. When their pattern is complete, exhibitors are excused from the showing area to complete the first tack change but must remain in the holding area. **2.** Hunt Seat Equitation will be judged as a group on the rail and may include the judge calling for maneuvers commonly seen in Equitation patterns including picking up correct diagonals, pivots, and transitions. It will be judged on the rider's form and effectiveness in all gaits. **3.** Tack change in the area. All exhibitors will line up in the arena, grooms ready at the gate, exhibitors must remain on their horse until the timer begins. 5 minute limit, one groom per horse permitted, wheelbarrows allowed to change to western attire. **4.** Western Command (often called "Simon Says") is a rail class where exhibitors must precisely execute the judge's real-time maneuvers. Requested elements may include the walk, jog, lope, gait extensions, pivots, sidepasses, and lead changes. This is an elimination-style event, any break of gait, missed maneuver, or excessive delay will have the horse called to the center by the judges until there is one horse remaining. Horses will be placed in this portion as they are eliminated.

Scoring: 30% Showmanship, 30% Equitation, 10% Tack Change, 30% Western

Ranch Disciplined Rail: Open to all exhibitors! A rail class evaluating a ranch horse's quality of movement, manners, and precision response to the judge's commands. In addition to basic ranch gaits (walk, trot, extended trot, lope, and extended lope), exhibitors may be asked for specialized disciplined maneuvers



including but limited to: immediate transitions, side-passing, pivots, counter-canter, lead changes, and standing quietly on a loose rein. Judged on the horse's obedience, timely transitions, and willingness as a working partner. Standard ranch apparel, tack, and grooming rules apply.

RULES & DETAILS

All classes will follow the 2026 APHA Rule Book

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to understand the classes before entering the arena

ENTRIES: Please submit a complete entry form by midnight, July 15, 2026 for each horse. A complete entry includes current registration papers and current APHA Membership cards, and applicable 2026 Amateur or Youth cards. Check your card status online at www.apha.myshowday.com to avoid a rush fee at the show! Incomplete entries or entries received after July 15, 2026, will be charged at the post-entry fee. **PLEASE NOTE:** It is extremely important that all exhibitors and/or owners review their entries and results for accuracy, and any discrepancies be brought to the attention of show staff immediately for review.

MEMBERSHIPS: A current APHA membership is needed to compete in APHA-approved classes. It is recommended to apply for Youth/Amateur/Novice/Walk-Trot cards ahead of time to avoid rush fees.

FEES: All fees are posted in Canadian funds. Entries payable by cash, cheque [payable to APHA Zone 10], or e-transfer [aphazone10@gmail.com] at the show; please do not pay entries prior to show. Please leave a blank check with the show office. Entry fees must be settled with the show secretary within 30 minutes of final class on Sunday. **Any unsettled accounts** will be charged a **\$100** late fee. **NSF Cheques** will be charged a **\$50** fee.

PAYING IN US FUNDS: US Cash or US Cheques are accepted! If paying in US funds, please let the show office know ahead of time. A 20% discount will be applied to your show bill and the amount owing to be paid at PAR. US Exhibitors please pay your stall fees and entries at the show with US Cheques or US Cash. *Clarification: \$500 Unlimited classes + 20% discount = \$400 USD*

APHA & PAYnt POINTS FEES: As charged by APHA based on class entries. These fees are not included with office, class, or unlimited class fees. More info: www.apha.com/PAYntPoints

DRUG TESTING: All horses entering the show may be subject to random drug testing. This will include blood samples collected by a veterinarian. Refusal of testing constitutes disqualification from the show, forfeiture of all entry fees, prize monies, and awards won.

OFFICE HOURS: The office will open at least one half hour prior to the scheduled show start time and will remain open at least one half hour following the last class of the day. Please check the website and social media for Thursday Office hours.

STALL RESERVATIONS: Stall reservations must be received before July 15, 2026 or post-entry rate will apply. Early arrivals may arrive any time after 12 noon, Wednesday July 29th, 2026.

RV/CAMPING RESERVATIONS: Reservations must be submitted to APHA Zone 10; spots will be assigned. Dry campers must also submit a reservation.

REFUNDS: Entries, stalls, and camping, are non-refundable without a veterinarian or medical certificate.

SCRATCHES OR CLASS ADDS: Adds and scratches can be made online! Visit www.aphazone10.com/2026-2 Please notify the show office of any scratches or adds well in advance of the class. Entries may be allowed at the gate as long as the exhibitor and horse have already been entered in the show at the office.

CROSS ENTRY: APHA cross-entry rules apply in APHA-Approved classes. Per APHA rules, APHA Walk-Trot exhibitors may not enter any Walk-Trot-Canter class, APHA or non-APHA, during the show. Ranch horse cross entry rules do not apply to *non-APHA-approved* classes only.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: Please review the 2026 APHA Rule book for complete class descriptions, qualifying, and allowed equipment.

LEADLINE: Youth Leadline (non-APHA) class entries are free. Leadline competitors must wear a helmet when showing. Open to exhibitors 10 years of age or under. Shown at a walk only on the lead line. Exhibitors may not enter any other riding classes at Zone-O-Rama. Horses may be of any breed or ownership. Please enter at the show office by the start of the show on the day Leadline is scheduled to run. Handlers must be at least 16 years old.

COMBINING OR SPLITTING CLASSES: Show Management reserves the right to split or combine classes based on entries. If there are insufficient entries, the classes will be combined by show management. Please refer to the APHA rule book for specific rules on splitting and combining in Youth, Amateur, Open, and Halter classes.

YOUTH 13 & UNDER: Per APHA rules, exhibitors have the option to enter either the 13 & under or 18 and under class but may not enter both on the same horse.

MASTERS AMATEUR: Per APHA rules, exhibitors have the option to enter either the Masters Amateur or Amateur All Ages class but may not enter both on the same horse. If there are insufficient entries (less than six entries in one or both), the classes will be combined by show management.

JUNIOR & SENIOR OPEN: Per APHA rules, Show management may combine or split age groups as justified by entries if there is unanimous consent of all involved exhibitors. If there are insufficient entries (less than three entries in either class), the classes will be combined by show management in order to make the division a one APHA-point earning division.

**AWARDS:**
